Mark A. Covaleski, PhD., is a Professor of Health Care Financial Management in the School of Business at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. Dr. Covaleski has become a nationally known speaker and educator on financial management in the health care setting. His programs have been oriented to a variety of professionals (physician, nurse, and other clinical managers and executives) for a variety of health care provider organizations. Amongst the organizations that he has presented to include: *Mayo Clinic*, *Harvard Community Health Plan*, *Advocate Health Care Systems* (Chicago), *Legacy Health Care System* (Portland, Oregon), *Presbyterian Hospital System* (Dallas), *Catholic Health Initiatives* (Denver), *Brigham and Women's Hospital* (Boston), *Mercy Health Systems* (Detroit), *Veterans' Administration*, and numerous others. He also teaches in the Masters of Medical Management Program at Tulane University.

Dr. Covaleski is a three-time recipient of the *Teacher of the Year Award* by the Health Services Administration Student Association, and two-time recipient of the "*Golden Apple*" *Teaching Award* in Administrative Medicine. He has been awarded the *Mabel W. Chipman Excellence in Teaching Award* which is granted to a School of Business faculty member for outstanding teaching. Dr. Covaleski is also a board member for a variety of health and social service organizations, and has received the *Robert A. Jerred Distinguished Service Award* which is granted to a School of Business faculty member who has an outstanding record of public service.

Dr. Covaleski has published over 60 articles in a variety of academic journals and has also published his work in several book chapters pertaining to healthcare financial management. He has also received a number of research grants in a variety of collaborative efforts including from: the *National Science Foundation*; the *National Cancer Advisory Board*; the State of Wisconsin's *Department of Health and Social Services*; the *Institute of Internal Auditors' Research Foundation*; the *National Institute for Mental Health*; and the *Kellogg Foundation*.

Dr. Covaleski received his PhD. from the Pennsylvania State University, an M.B.A. at the University of Utah, and his B.S. from Gannon College. He is a licensed C.P.A. in the State of Wisconsin.
