Dr. Mark Pierce is Medical Director of Knowledge & Informatics Management at Parkview Health, a seven hospital health system in Fort Wayne, Indiana. He continues in primary care practice being board-certified in Internal Medicine and in Pediatrics. He completed his residency training at the Baylor College of Medicine in Houston, Texas and at the Methodist Hospital in Indianapolis and received his MD from Indiana University. He has successfully started Med-Peds practices in South Bend and in Fort Wayne, Indiana and currently provides outpatient, inpatient, and teaching clinical services.

Dr. Pierce has been an early adopter and a trailblazer in the use of information technology in redefining delivery of healthcare of the highest quality. Serving as Chairman of the Information Technology Committee and a member of the Executive Committee of Parkview Medical Group, a 45-physician primary care group in Parkview Health System, Dr. Pierce led the evaluation and selection process for their ambulatory electronic medical record which is now being deployed across the 19 locations in the medical group. Dr. Pierce has played a significant role in Parkview Health System's deployment of IDX's Carecast acute care solution serving as Physician Champion for the system-wide "go-live" in May of 2004. He continues his work in Informatics now focusing on knowledge management in healthcare information technology and with a particular effort on medication management and reconciliation. Dr. Pierce is a frequent and welcome speaker at IDX's Physician Advisory Group and has presented at their National User's Conference.
